Supporting children to be environmentally aware of their world through recycling and caring for our outdoor environment and wider community e.g., gardening, picking up rubbish walks.	-Establish prior know-ledge of the children. -Intentional teaching of caring for our world skills. -Incorporate recycling into daily practices. -Children to germinate seeds, learn to propagate, water, and take care of the plants. -Establish a worm farm, utilise food scraps to feed the worms and make our own worm fertiliser.
